1939 First draft of VB's "As We May Think" for Fortune

1941-47: VB serves as FDR's Director of Scientific Research

1945: VB publishes "As We May Think" in Atlantic Monthly

1965: Nelson's Hypertext model at ACM Conference ("Writing that can't be printed out.")

1968: Engelbart's Mother of All Demos: mouse, GUI, links

1977: Introduction of Apple II computer

1990: Tim Berners-Lee at CERN introduces World Wide Web and gives it away

1992: Commerically available **browser:** Andreeson and Bina build Mosaic → Netscape Navigator

1996: Search engines rotate on Netscape Navigator

2000: Google

2004: Google Book Search (Frankfurt Book Fair)
