
JULY SHORTS DISCOUNT

RECEIVING PRINT CATALOGS

We are excited to announce that the fall catalog will be mailed out mid-July. We have a feature in member accounts that allows you to indicate if you prefer not to receive print catalogs in the mail. **If you don't want to receive print** catalogs:

- Log into your member account on the **OLLI website**.
- Click on your name at the top of the page and then go to "Edit Account" on the left
- Uncheck the box next to "Receive Print Catalogs." (See image below.)

If you want to continue receiving catalogs, **no action is necessary.** If you and your spouse **both** receive catalogs, but just one would be sufficient, please log into one of your member accounts and follow the steps above to uncheck the box.





HEARING LOOPS

All of the classrooms at OLLI have hearing loops installed. "Hearing loops" are state-of-the-art "Listening Assistive" technology. There are three main parts to a hearing loop: the wire that is installed around and across the room, a microphone, and a transceiver (which picks up and amplifies the sound from the microphone). The system both amplifies the speaker's voice and suppresses background noise. We

urge everyone who has hearing loss to take advantage of the hearing loops. The sound is remarkable. It's as if the person speaking is sitting right next to you.
