# Fall Registration Is Open

Registration is now OPEN on the OLLI website for the **fall semester (September 19-December 2).** Classes are offered online, in-person, and hybrid. In the catalog, each course description lists the format. When registering for a hybrid class, you must select whether you want to attend in-person (Hybrid In-Person) or by Zoom (Hybrid Zoom). List both formats if the class is a priority and you are willing to attend either format. You can prioritize up to 12 classes for the lottery. As always, the lottery will then assign you to up to three classes. The membership fee (\$300 for the semester or \$550 for both fall and spring) allows you to register for three study groups before the lottery and then add a fourth after you receive your registration confirmation letter. To add a fourth class, you no longer need to contact the office-simply log into your account on the website.

The **fall lottery is September 6**. Be sure to **register by 8:00 AM on September 6** for the best chance of getting into your preferred study groups. <u>View classes and register for the fall semester.</u>

# Open Courses for the July Shorts

The July Shorts take place next week, but there are still open courses available. Register by close of business today, July 8. Members may register for up to three courses for \$75. Check your email for a digital form from DocuSign to attest that you are fully vaccinated and boosted against COVID-19 in accordance with American University's policy. You do not need to enroll in DocuSign. Just press the "Review Document" button, type your name as a signature, and submit it.
