
Truman Signs North Atlantic Treaty, April 4, 1949



Article 5 North Atlantic Treaty

"The Parties of NATO agree that an armed attack against one or more of them in Europe or North America shall be considered an attack against them all. Consequently they agree that, if such an armed attack occurs, each of them, in exercise of the right of individual or collective self-defence recognised by Article 51 of the Charter of the United Nations, will assist the Party or Parties being attacked, individually and in concert with the other Parties, by such action as it deems necessary, including the use of armed force, to restore and maintain the security of the North Atlantic area".






