It is not necessary to "understand" everything you notice.

Please WAIT to do any outside reading about these poems, or to bring prior knowledge immediately to bear. Starting fresh with what YOU notice, unprompted, will benefit the group. Read such materials after our group meeting, keeping our recent discussion in mind. (I will provide some materials, and you can find more).

Next week, whether or not you have read further. we will begin with a conversation about how your thoughts about the poems have evolved.
