# The Bloodless Implosion of East Germany in 1989 – the open and hidden driving forces

My motivation for a closer look: memoirs and interviews of former EGerman leaders reveal new insights

- --- why did EGermany implode? Answers complex but pretty clear
- --- why did EGermany implode without violence? Not clear, since force is very foundation of state
  - --- EGermany exists because of perceived Soviet military need
  - ---- EGermany uses violence daily at border and internally
  - ---- communists everywhere before, and again in June 1989 in China used massive violence against dissidents

## Our task is to understand what happened from

1969 : cold war is very cold, Viet Nam war

to 20 years later

1989/90: East Germany dissolves without violence
